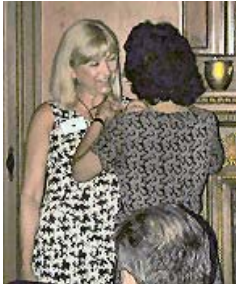

Information on tickets and ad pricing will be coming soon!

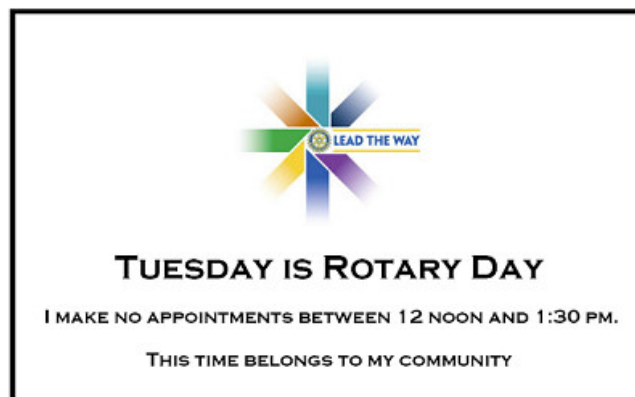
